The Joint Annual Meeting of the Canadian Archaeological Association/Association Canadienne d'archéologie (CAA/ACA) and Archaeological Society of Alberta – Calgary Centre (ASA) will be held in Canmore, Alberta, from May 6-10, 2026.

This large meeting will welcome up to 400 professional, academic, and avocational archaeologists from across Canada, as well as University students, Indigenous participants and interested members of the public. Attendees will present the results of their archaeological research via presentations and posters, as well as participate in local fieldtrips in the Bow Valley and a banquet.
